



Direction of travel Please note – Earlier models have Part no 0801-PCHTA-FB (see below) as a stop tube on a long adjusting bolt, more recent models have a short adjusting bolt, 0801-PCHTA-SB. These appear on the rear of both outer wings only. Both serve the same function. After setting the tail tensioners with the correct thread exposed, tighten the Chain Tension Adjusters on the wing. Diag. 6 Adjust until the chain "springs" back to position when you roll the gang of discs back and forth. Check the Rear Tension Assemblies to see that the face of the spring retaining bushing is flush with the end of the tension assembly body. (Diag. 4) Long Adjusting bolt with spacer tube. 0801-PCHTA-FB Short Adjusting bolt. 0801-PCHTA-SB
